Master Chief Clark entered the United States Navy in December 1983 and attended basic training in Great Lakes, Illinois. Upon completion of Avionics Class "A" School and Advanced First Term Avionics course in Millington, Tennessee, he reported to Fleet Air Reconnaissance Squadron ONE (VQ-1) at NAS Agana, Guam where he deployed aboard USS MIDWAY (CV 41) and USS RANGER (CV 61) in support of the EA-3B Skywarrior.

His ship's company tours include Pre-Commissioning Unit/Aircraft Intermediate Maintenance Department (AIMD) USS GEORGE WASHINGTON (CVN 73) homeport Norfolk, Virginia and AIMD USS CARL VINSON (CVN 70) homeport Bremerton, Washington.

His shore duty assignments include instructor duty at Naval Air Technical Training Center Millington, Tennessee. Recruiter in Charge, Navy Recruiting Station, Twin Falls, Idaho and Assistant Maintenance Officer at U. S. Naval Test Pilot School, Patuxent River, Maryland.

Master Chief Clark attended the Navy Senior Enlisted Academy in the fall of 2004 prior to reporting aboard as Command Master Chief for Electronic Attack Squadron ONE THREE TWO (VAQ 132) where he deployed to Iwakuni, Japan and Al Asad Air Base, Iraq.

In May 2008, he reported to Patrol Squadron FORTY as the Fighting Marlin's Command Master Chief where he deployed to Ali Air Base, Iraq in 2009 and Kadena Air Base Okinawa, Japan in 2011.

In May 2012 Master Chief Clark reported aboard Patrol and Reconnaissance Wing TEN as Command Master Chief.

His personal awards include the Meritorious Service Medal, five Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medals, three Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medals as well as various campaign and unit awards.
